New Room Layout



Due to recent changes from OFSTED and an update to our company policy we must adhere to the following points:

- Parents/carers must inform the club if they are planning holidays so that we can record this on our register.
- If your child is sick or cannot attend the club for any other reason, please call us on the club phone number 07841 867427 as early as possible.
- If we do not hear from you within half an hour of when you are due to arrive at breakfast club the Manager or Deputy Manager will contact you to establish why your child is absent. In the after school club we require you to contact us either by phone, text or email to inform us, and all absences will be recorded appropriately.
- If we are concerned about the welfare of a child we reserve the right to contact the appropriate services.
- Fees remain payable during periods of absence, unless alternative arrangements have been agreed.
